- ✔ Protecting the right to vote against threats and implementing voting systems that are free, fair, and accessible.
- ✔ Advocating for positive lasting changes at the local, state, and national level on issues such as education, government accountability, and money in politics.
- ✔ Bridging the partisan divide by fostering civil discourse on topics of community interest such as climate change, economic inequity, judicial independence, and much more.



# BECOME A FORCE FOR CHANGE

## VOTER SERVICES

- ✔ Produce nonpartisan Voters Guides for each election. Help voters make informed choices by developing candidate questions on pressing public policy issues.
- ✔ Organize and present candidate forums for key local elections, in conjunction with local broadcasters, libraries, and community centers.

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- ✔ Present and distribute voter education materials with local community partners.
- ✔ Register hundreds of new citizens to vote every month at USCIS naturalization ceremonies in San Antonio.
- ✔ Conduct personal and direct-mail outreach to thousands of residents and registered voters in Bexar County's lowest-turnout precincts.

## YOUTH INITIATIVE

- ✔ Organize the annual youth contest.
- ✔ Encourage political responsibility among young voters.
- ✔ Develop presentations on the importance of voting.

## PUBLIC POLICY EDUCATION

- ✔ Host public policy forums with local experts and officials on key issues such as redistricting, climate change, and human trafficking.
